- 1 Seeks a commitment from all political parties contesting the March 2023 NSW elections to amend the Rural Fire Services Act 1997 to remove Section 119's reference to vesting RFS equipment with councils to resolve the conflict of "control", specifically in accordance with the definition in Australian Accounting Standards Board (AASB) Statement of Accounting Concepts 4: Definition and Recognition of the Elements of Financial Statements.
- 2 Write to the NSW Treasurer and Minister for Emergency Services and Resilience requesting urgent attention be given to this matter in light of:
 - a) i. Pending qualified audits of more than half of the state's Local Government organisations due to a conflict in accounting positions; and ii. Actual qualified opinions that have now been given to a number of Councils across NSW;
 - b) Immediate action be taken to ensure the NSW Rural Fire Service is an entity under the same requirements and regulations as other emergency service organisations such as the State Emergency Service.
