

- Expressed concern at the closing of Main Street businesses and requested an urgent review of economic development functions

### Cr McGlynn

- Requested for staff to focus on economic development initiatives
- Requested a review of the Saleyards precinct to identify potential opportunities for usage
- Requested the Procurement Policy be listed on the Council Workshop agenda

#### **Cr Templeton**

- Queried Council's access to reduced electricity prices
  GM advised that Council's electricity services are currently contracted through REROC and is investigating services through Local Government Procurement
- Expressed concern at the balance for economic development and the impacts of major business on small family owned operations

#### **Cr Pokoney**

- Requested a broader scope and consultation for economic development
- Advised that a Business Sector supper is planned for 8<sup>th</sup> July at 7pm in the Chambers
